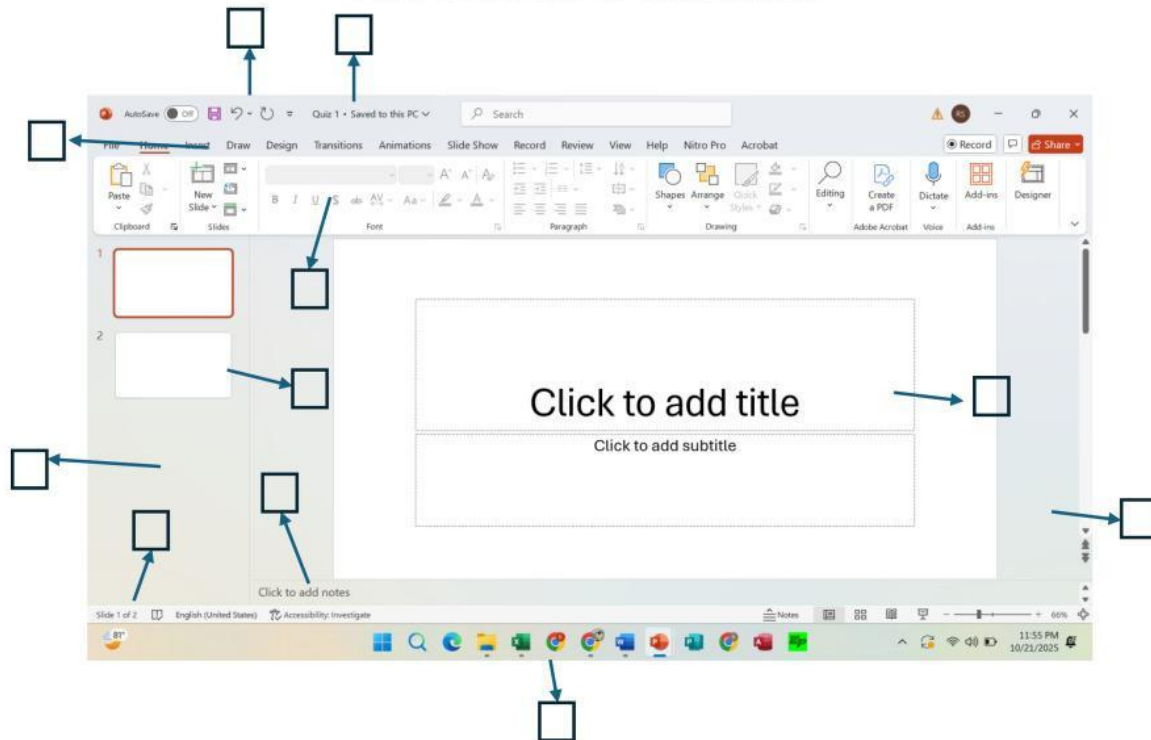


## Parts of the PowerPoint Window

	Used to insert text, content or SmartArt onto the slide
	Used to insert important points about the slide. This is only visible to the presenter during a presentation
	Shortcuts to regularly used commands
	Area on the window here the thumbnails are kept. Used to select and rearrange slides.
	A list of icons
	Individual slides in the task/slider pane
	This area displays the name of the slide and the program we are working in
	Individual sheets in a PowerPoint presentation
	The area on the window that displays the number of slides
	Also called the file tabs. It contains a list of options to choose from
