Present Perfect	Past Simple
(+) I/ we/ you/ they <i>have</i> + V3 He/ she/ it <i>has</i> + V3	(+) V2/ V+ed
(-) I/ we/ you/ they <i>haven't</i> + V3 He/ she/ it <i>hasn't</i> + V3	(-) didn't + V1
(?) Have/ has + subject + V3?	(?) Did + subject + V1?

- When we ask about experience in general, we use Present Perfect/ Past Simple. (Time, place and other details AREN'T important)
- When we need to learn the details, we use Present Perfect/ Past Simple. (Time, place, etc. ARE important)
