


# FRUITS



## Across

4. A bell-shaped fruit that is usually green or brown.
5. A small, sour, green citrus fruit, similar to a lemon.
6. A small, round fruit that grows in clusters and can be made into juice or wine.
7. A small, dark purple or red fruit with a single pit (seed) in the middle.
9. A round, citrus fruit that shares its name with a colour.

## Down

1. A round, red, green, or yellow fruit often eaten whole.
2. A small, fuzzy brown fruit with bright green flesh inside.
3. A very sweet tropical fruit with a large, flat seed inside.
5. A sour yellow citrus fruit used to make juice or flavour food.
8. A small, red, sweet fruit, often eaten with cream or in a pie (e.g., strawberry).
