Quick Grammar Guide

Before you begin, here's a quick review of sentence parts and punctuation to help you with the worksheet.

1. Sentence Components:

Subject: The person or thing doing the action. Example: 'The dog barked.' →

Subject: The dog

Verb: The action or state of being. Example: 'The dog barked.' → Verb: barked

Object: The person or thing receiving the action. Example: 'She reads a book.'

→ Object: a book

2. Punctuation:

Period (.) ends a sentence. Example: 'I like pizza.'

Comma (,) separates ideas or items in a list. Example: 'I bought apples, oranges, and bananas.'

Capital letters start sentences and proper nouns. Example: 'Monday is my favorite day.'
