Form Review

Positive: Subject + base verb+ **ED / past simple (V2)**

- I/You/We/They **wanted/ went**
- He/She/It **wanted/ went**

Negative: Subject + didn't + base verb

- I/You/We/They **didn't want/ go**
- He/She/It **didn't want/ go**

Questions: Did + subject + base verb

- **Did you want/go?**
- **Did she want/go?**
