ABOUT BAKPIA

Bakpia is a famous traditional snack from Yogyakarta, Indonesia. It is a small, round pastry with a soft outer skin and a sweet filling inside. The most common filling is mung bean (kacang hijau), but nowadays there are many modern flavors such as chocolate, cheese, durian, and green tea. Bakpia is often enjoyed as a snack with tea or coffee and is also a popular souvenir for tourists who visit Jogja.

Bakpia was first introduced to Yogyakarta by Chinese immigrants. The name “bakpia” comes from the Chinese words “bak” (meat) and “pia” (pastry). Over time, Indonesians adapted the recipe by using sweet mung bean instead of meat, making it suitable for everyone. One of the most famous places to buy bakpia is Bakpia Pathok, located near Malioboro Street.
