

Let's Talk About Sports!

Learning Objectives: By the end, you will be able to use the Present Simple in affirmative form and ask/answer 'why' questions with 'because'.

My friends and I love sports! My friend Tom **plays football** on Saturdays. My sister, Jane, **plays basketball** after school. On weekends, we sometimes **play table tennis** in the park. In the summer, my family **goes swimming** at the beach. My cousin Mark is adventurous; he **goes climbing** in the mountains and sometimes he **goes abseiling** too! I like trying new things. I **go trampolining** at the sports center. My friend Sarah **does gymnastics**, and her brother **does archery**.

We add **-s/-es/-ies** to the verb for **he, she, it**.

I / you / we / they

play football
go swimming
study English

He / she / it

plays football
go**es** swimming
stud**ies** archery

Asking 'Why?' with 'to be'

Use **'Why...?'** to ask for a reason.

Use **'Because...'** to give the reason.

Q: Why is he excited?

A: Because he goes abseiling.



He is excited because he's going abseiling.
