A. GRAMMAR: Present continuous for future meaning (Thì hiện tại tiếp diễn với ý nghĩa tương lai)

- Cách dùng:** Dùng để nói về kế hoạch đã được sắp xếp, lên lịch chắc chắn trong tương lai gần.
- Dấu hiệu nhận biết:** Thường có các từ chỉ thời gian tương lai gần, ví dụ:
 - + **tomorrow** (ngày mai)
 - + **this weekend** (cuối tuần này)
 - + **next week / next month / next Monday** (tuần / tháng / thứ ... tới)
 - + **tonight** (tối nay)
 - + **in the morning / afternoon / evening** (vào buổi sáng / chiều / tối)
 - + **soon / later** (sắp, lát nữa)

	Structure	Example
Positive	S + am/is/are + V-ing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I am meeting my friend tomorrow. - She is flying to Da Nang next week. - We are having a class party this Saturday.
Negative	S + am/is/are + not + V-ing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I am not meeting my friend tomorrow. - She is not flying to Da Nang next week. - We are not having a class party this Saturday.

S: chủ ngữ; V-ing: dạng thêm -ing của động từ.


