Shapes are all around us! Every day, we see different shapes in the world. Let's learn about some common shapes. A circle is round and it has no corners. You can find circles in things like wheels, coins, and basketballs. A circle is a shape that goes around and around. A triangle has three sides and three corners. You can see triangles in things like a slice of pizza, a

birthday hat, and the roof of a house. Some triangles are tall, while others are short.

A rectangle has 2 long sides and 2 short sides. It also has four corners. You can find rectangles in books, doors, and tables. A square is a **special** kind of rectangle where all four sides are the same length. You can see squares in chess boards, windows, and many tiles. Shapes help us **understand** the world around us. Next time you go outside, look for these shapes in your surroundings!

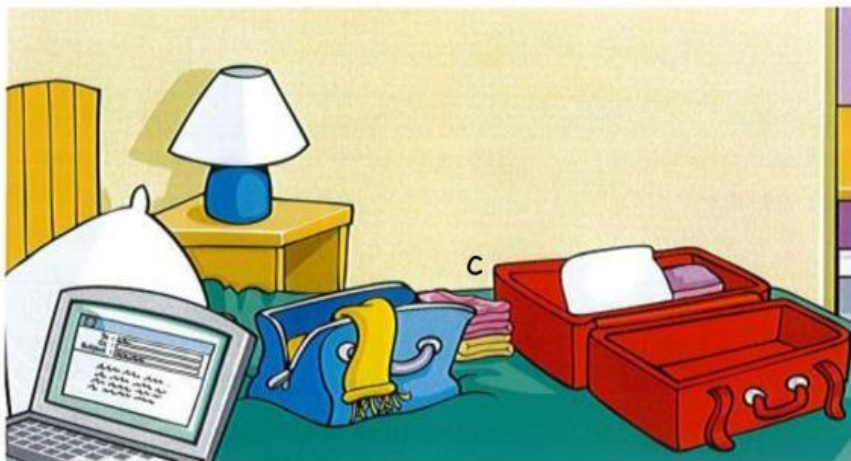
