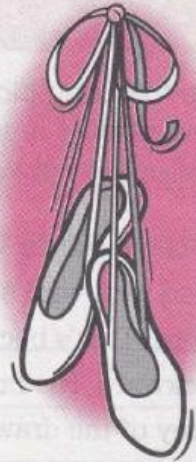



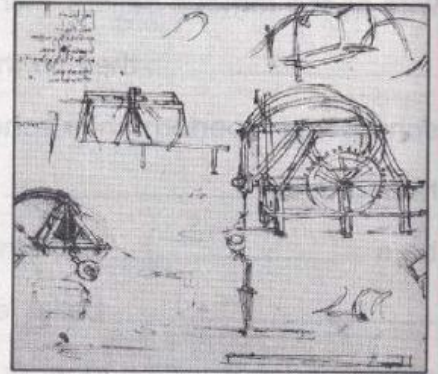
Proofreading
