

## Modal Verb Word Cards

**Front of Card:** *(Word)*

**Back of Card:** *(Meaning/Example)*

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### Card 1

**Front:** may

**Back:** shows permission or possibility

● *Example:* You **may** go outside after lunch.

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### Card 2

**Front:** can

**Back:** shows ability or permission

● *Example:* I **can** ride a bike.

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### Card 3

**Front:** must

**Back:** shows necessity or something you have to do

● *Example:* You **must** finish your homework.

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### Card 4

**Front:** would

**Back:** shows polite request or something imagined

● *Example:* **Would** you like some juice?
