The present simple (3): have

The present simple affirmative and negative



Affirmative

I play
you play
he plays
she plays
it plays
we play
you play
they play

Negative

I do not play
you do not play
he does not play
she does not play
it does not play
we do not play
you do not play
they do not play

Short forms

I don't play
you don't play
he doesn't play
she doesn't play
it doesn't play
we don't play
you don't play
they don't play

We use the present simple to talk about:

- habits and things that we do regularly
We walk to school.
- facts and things that are always true
London is the capital of England.
- opinions *I don't like cricket.*



Spelling rules

Look at the spelling rules for the **he**, **she** and **it** forms of the present simple affirmative.

Verb	Example	Add	Form
most verbs	play	+ -s	plays
verbs ending consonant + -y	study	y + -ies	studies
verbs ending -s, -ch, -sh, -x, -o or -z	watch	+ -es	watches

Remember that some verbs are irregular, e.g. **have**, **can** and **be**.



you don't have

he doesn't have

she doesn't have

it doesn't have

we don't have

you don't have

they don't have

Do you have?

Do they have?



In my family, we **have** dinner at 7.30 every evening.

Note that short answers are the same as for regular verbs.

Do you have dinner at 7.30? Yes, we do.
