WHY WE STILL LOVE GREAT TV



These days, we have more TV shows to choose from than ever before. Every week, new series appear on different streaming platforms, from exciting dramas to romantic comedies and even reality shows. But what makes a series truly unforgettable?



Many fans say it's all about the characters. Take *The Crown*, for example. The show follows the life of Queen Elizabeth II, and even after several final episodes, viewers still discuss their favourite characters online. Others prefer something less predictable, like *Stranger Things*. The mix of horror, humour, and friendship keeps people guessing, and its special effects are by far the best on television right now.

Some people think TV shows have become too much like Hollywood films—full of expensive effects but less interesting stories. A viewer recently said, “The first seasons were amazing, but now it feels too predictable. You can almost see every twist coming!”

However, not all shows are losing their magic. The Korean drama *Moving* became a global hit because it was full of emotion and unpredictable storylines. Meanwhile, the fantasy series *The Witcher* still attracts millions of fans who say it's exciting to watch how every hero faces their destiny.



Writers also face challenges. Once a story reaches the end of the original books, as happened with *Game of Thrones*, it becomes harder to keep things fresh. “They used to be braver with the story,” one critic said. “Now, some endings feel safe.”

Still, one thing is clear: people around the world continue to love great storytelling. Whether it's revenge, friendship, or adventure, every show gives us something to talk about. As one fan said, “I reckon we just like to be surprised.”
