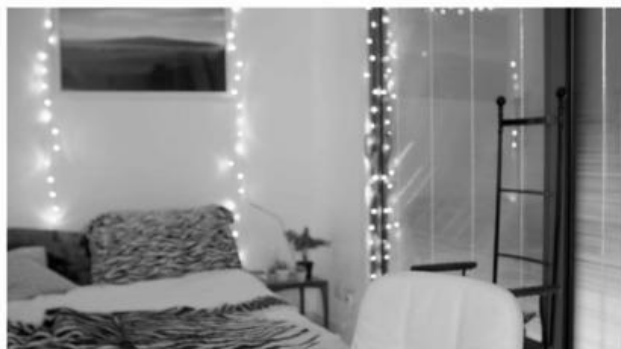

- 1 Look at the picture. Why is Leo not there? Where is he?

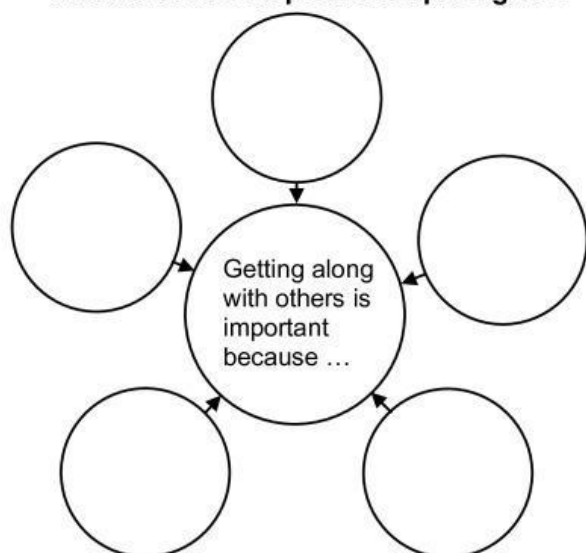


- 2 Work in pairs. Leo and his sister don't get along. Choose four things Leo does to annoy her.

- 4 Compare your spidergram with a partner. How many reasons are the same? How many are different?

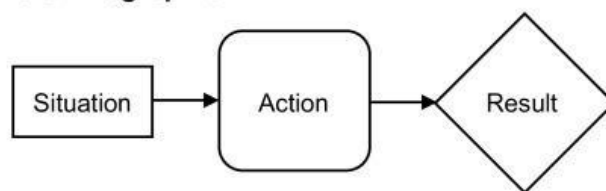
- 5 Work in pairs and read about Camilla's situation. Answer the questions.
