When Paul's grandfather was young, he worked at a zoo. He likes showing his photos of the animals to his two (1), Peter and Jim, and his granddaughter, Sally.

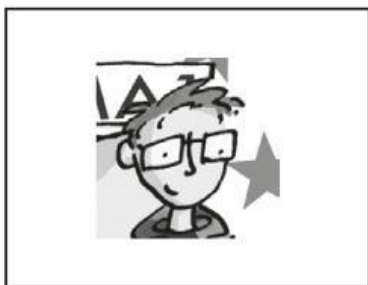

'Which were your favourite animals?' Sally asked.

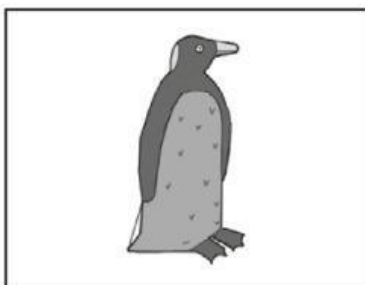
