He has / doesn't have to load / unload the washing machine - the cycle's done.




The window panes are really dirty. You have / don't have to clean / clear them.

I have / don't have to lay / clear the table after dinner - it's my sister's turn.




She's a janitor, so she has / doesn't have to clean / clear a lot.
