DID YOU KNOW? After the common cold or flu, stomachaches are the most common reason why people go to see the doctor.

Dengue Fever

This disease is transmitted to humans by the bite of a mosquito called Aedes Aegypti, which feeds during the day. This infectious disease is manifested by a sudden high fever with a very bad headache, muscle pain and rashes.

Other symptoms include:

- Fever
- Chills
- Constant headaches
- Bleeding from nose, mouth or gums
- Severe dizziness and loss of appetite



Medicines come with directions about how to use them.
Always be careful and read the instructions.

Dengue fever is treated under the supervision of a doctor. The patient has to go to a health center or a hospital and rest while intravenous fluids and antibiotics work to keep the patient hydrated and out of danger. This treatment may last up to 7 days.

We can all help prevent the Dengue mosquito from breeding and hatching by draining the water from non used containers such as plastic cups, used tires, broken bottles, flower pots, etc.


