Structure	Example
<b>MAKE</b> + object + <i>infinitive without TO</i>	My parents make me tidy my room.
<b>LET</b> + object + <i>infinitive without TO</i>	They let us use our phones at break time.
<b>BE ALLOWED TO</b> + <i>infinitive</i>	We are allowed to leave early on Fridays. I wasn't allowed to go to the party.
