2. _____ is an input device that reads images or text and converts the data into digital signals.
3. _____ is device that displays text and graphics generated by a computer.
4. _____ is compact disc read-only memory: a compact disc used with a computer system as a read-only optical disc.
5. _____ is an equipment for taking photographs (usually consisting of a lightproof box with a lens at one end and light-sensitive film at the other).
6. _____ is a digital camera designed to take digital photographs and transmit them over the internet.
7. _____ is a machine that prints out results on paper.
8. _____ is a portable, solid-state data storage device that uses flash memory with an integrated USB interface.
9. _____ is a data input device for computers that uses an arrangement of buttons, or keys, to enter text, numbers, symbols, and commands.
10. _____ is the main circuit board of a computer, usually containing the central processing unit and main system memory as well as circuitry that controls the disk drives, keyboard, monitor, and other peripheral devices.
11. _____ is a computer input device that allows one to hand-draw images and graphics, similar to the way one draws images with a pencil and paper.
12. _____ is one or more wires or optical fibers bound together, typically in a common protective jacket or sheath. The individual wires or fibers inside the jacket may be covered or insulated.
13. _____ are output devices that convert electrical audio signals into sound waves that humans can hear.
14. _____ is a flat surface placed on a desk or table to provide an optimal area for a computer mouse to operate.
15. _____ is a wireless networking technology that uses radio waves to provide high-speed internet access and communication between electronic devices without the need for physical cables.
16. _____ is the component that supplies power to a computer.
17. _____ is a device installed in a wall, floor, or on a power strip that allows electrical equipment to connect to the main power supply.
