Formation

Subject + had + past participle

My brother had already done the ironing when I arrived home.



Affirmative
Interrogative
Negative

I had been	You had been	He/She/It had been
Had I been?	Had you been?	Had he/she/it had been?
I hadn't been	You hadn't been	He/She/It hadn't been

USES

You are referring to the past and want to say that something happened before another time also in the past:
When I arrived home, she had just left.
