

Subject-Verb Agreement: Quantifiers & Fractions

EXPLANATION & EXAMPLES:

When the subject includes a **quantifier or fraction**, the verb agrees with the noun that follows it.

Examples:

- Half of the students **are** here. (students = plural)
- Half of the cake **is** gone. (cake = singular)
- A number of people **are** waiting.
- The number of people **is** small.
- 25% of the water **is** clean.
- 25% of the bottles **are** empty.
