1. Singer Duc Phuc captivated both the audience and critics with his victory at the 2025 'Intervision' music contest in Moscow. Performing the Vietnamese song "Phu Dong Thien Vuong" (Heavenly Prince of Phu Dong), his win **garnered** widespread attention from Russian media, including Ria Novosti, Regnum, and Lenta. Phuc, 28, was invited by Vietnam's Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Tourism to participate in the contest. He first gained recognition in 2015 when he won "The Voice of Vietnam" and has since become known for his emotional ballads and compelling performances.

2. The Intervision Song Contest, initially organized by the International Radio and Television Organization (OIRT), was first held in Czechoslovakia from 1965 to 1968 and was later revived in Poland in the late 1970s. After a 40-year hiatus, the competition now attracts participants from countries such as Cuba, China, Egypt, the U.S., and Vietnam. Saudi Arabia is set to host next year's event.

3. People's Artist Igor Matvienko, one of the judges, praised Phuc's performance as "excellent," highlighting its modern and dramatic appeal while **incorporating** traditional Vietnamese elements. Rossiyskaya Gazeta also acknowledged **his** impressive vocal range and emotional delivery. Columnist Alexander Alekseev remarked that Phuc's performance stood out due to the thoughtful choice of melodies and costumes that reflected the beauty of Vietnamese culture.

4. Following the competition, Phuc shared that his chances were boosted by the generous gesture of Russia's contestant Shaman, who chose not to be scored, allowing other participants a better chance. Phuc also expressed plans to donate part of his prize to charity in Russia and to study the Russian language. He aims to compose a song in Russian and collaborate with local artists. **His performance was widely praised on social media, with many describing it as a powerful representation of Vietnamese culture.**
