

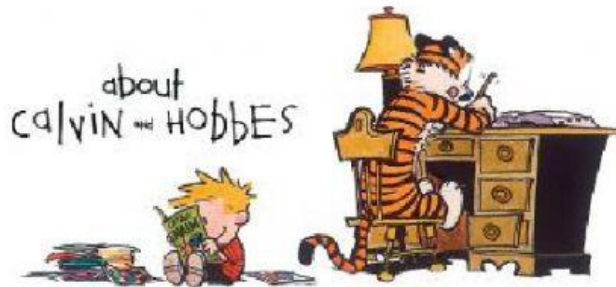
## Present simple and present continuous
