2. This is a free-floating plant with feathery roots that can reach up to 50 cm in length. The fleshy leaves are arranged circularly and resembles a floating head of lettuce _____.



3. This is one of the most ancient native plants of the United Kingdom. It grows up to 31 inches tall and its leaves are rounded and kidney-shaped _____.



4. This plant grows in various sizes. It grows perennially in colonies that can cover large amounts of ground. The roots are white and thin, covered with a purple skin. It is mostly found in shallow wetlands _____.



5. This plant is native to North America. It is used to treat the inflammation of the mucous membrane. The whole structure of the plant is quite striking when it blooms in spring _____.



6. This is an attractive plant with brightly coloured veins on its wide leaves. It is considered edible but it contains oxalic acid. So it should not be consumed in large quantities _____.
