TOURIST SPOTS IN INDIA 18

1. It is the most famous beach in Mumbai. It is famous for its Mumbai street food, especially bhelpuri, pani puri, sev puri, chaat and pav bhaji.
2. These gardens are laid out in the style of Mughal gardens. Situated 22 km from Chandigarh, the gardens have a zoo, a plant nursery, a Japanese garden and picnic lawns.
3. Located in the heart of Delhi, it is the combination of a food plaza and a craft bazaar. There are stalls of crafts from all over India, showcasing a wide variety of handicrafts.
4. Located in kolkata, it is the largest planetarium in the world. It provides a view of the stars and the solar system.
5. It is a large mansion located in Allahabad. Two of the Prime Ministers of India, namely Jawaharlal Nehru and Indira Gandhi, were born here. It is now converted into a museum.
6. Located in Hyderabad, it is the largest zoo in India. It is spread over an area of about 1.2 sq km. It has a wide variety of animals.
7. It is a Himalayan area in Uttarakhand. The area is surrounded by snow-capped mountains and is carpeted with over 500 species of flowers.
8. It is a narrow-gauge railway train that runs between Siliguri and Darjeeling in West Bengal. It is nicknamed the Toy Train.
