1. 	It is an infectious disease of the liver. It causes liver inflammation, vomiting and jaundice. SITITAPEH <input type="text"/>	2. 	The patient of this disease has high blood sugar. High blood sugar causes frequent urination, increases thirst and increased hunger. SETEBAID <input type="text"/>
3. 	It is a disease caused by the uncontrolled growth of cells in the brain. It interferes with brain functions such as muscle control, sensation, memory and other normal body functions. NIARB ROMUT <input type="text"/>	4. 	It is an acute viral disease which spreads from person to person. Different types of paralyes may occur, depending on the nerves affected. OILOP <input type="text"/>
5. 	It is a disease caused by excessive loss of water from the body. Its symptoms may include headache, decreased blood pressure or fainting. AEOHRRRAID <input type="text"/>	6. 	It is a form of joint disorder that involves inflammation of one or more joints. The major symptoms are difficulty in moving the joints, and weight loss. SITIRHTRA <input type="text"/>
7. 	It is discontinuity or break in a bodily membrane with loss of surface tissue, disintegration and often pus. RECLU <input type="text"/>	8. 	It is a common disease of the respiratory system. The patient coughs and pants during inhalation. AMHTS <input type="text"/>
