HSIFXOB WOLLEY _____

2. This blind deep-sea crab, whose legs are covered with long, pale-yellow hair, is nicknamed the 'Yeti crab', after the fable Yeti, the snowman of the Himalayas.

ATUSRIH AWIK _____

3. It is one of the world's most miserable and ugliest looking animals. It has very few muscles and moves very slowly. To eat, it waits on the bottom of the ocean for the prey to pass by.

HSIFBOLB _____

4. It is a small, deep-sea fish that gets its name from its teeth, which are actually the largest teeth of any fish in the ocean when considered in proportion to body size.

HTOOTGNAF _____

5. Found along the south-western coast of Australia, it has a large body and leaf-like appendages which enable it to hide among floating seaweed or kelp beds.

NOGARDAES YFAEL _____

6. Also known as the blowfish, it puffs up to about twice its normal size by gulping water when it is threatened. It is an extremely poisonous creature.

HSIF REFFUP _____

7. Found in the Gulf of Maine, this octopus glows with its own light. The light-emitting organs may be positioned to fool prey into swimming right into the mouth of the hunter.
