

Children's Day Around the World

Children's Day is a special day to celebrate kids everywhere! On this day, children are thanked for bringing joy, love, and laughter to the world. Different countries have different ways of celebrating. Let's see how some children around the world enjoy their special day!

In **Mexico**, Children's Day is called *El Día del Niño*. It is celebrated on **April 30th**. Schools often have fun parties instead of regular classes. In **China**, Children's Day is celebrated on **June 1st**. Schools give students the day off! Parks, zoos, and movie theaters are full of families. Children get small gifts from their parents or teachers, and everyone enjoys time together. Some cities even have parades and concerts for kids!
