

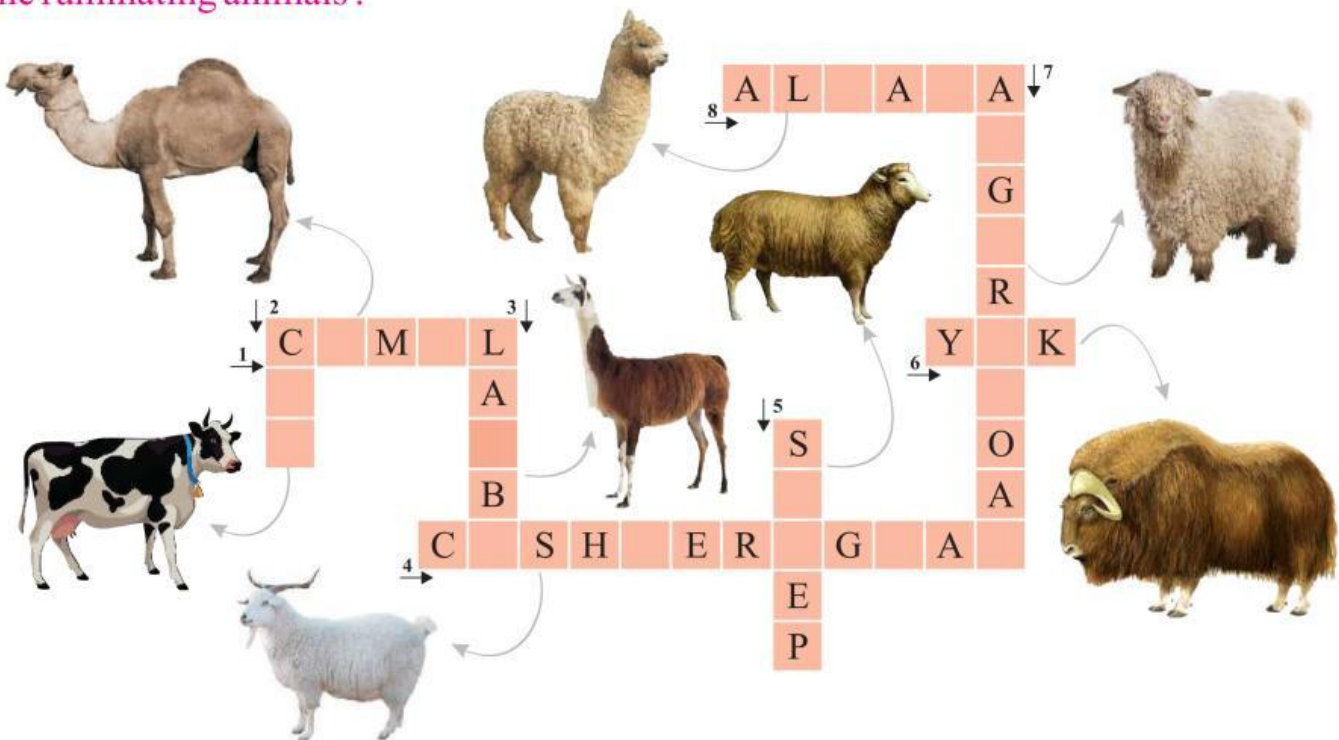


Ruminating Mammals

Clues (Down)

Clues (Across)
