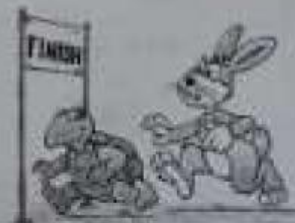
"I'm really sorry, Tatty." Rabbit learns a lesson he will never forget.

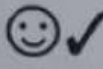
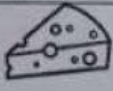
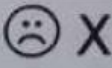
