The prefixes **pre** and **pro** usually mean before. **Pro** can also mean forward, as in progress.

The prefix **de** means down, not, or reverse. **De** can also mean apart or aside, as in dedicate.

The prefixes **con** and **com** mean with or together.

The prefix **mis** usually means bad or badly or wrong or wrongly.



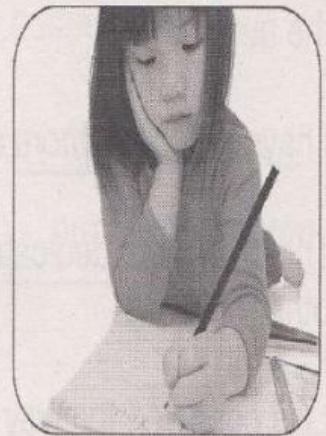
