



Our Respiratory System

Look at the diagram. Read what each part of the respiratory system does. Label each part of the respiratory system on the diagram by writing the correct number :

Lungs - the main part of the respiratory system; they put oxygen into the bloodstream

Trachea or windpipe - a tube that connects the upper respiratory system to the lungs

Nose - contains two nostrils through which air passes in and out of the body

Mouth - can be used to suck in or expel air

Bronchi - smaller tubes that bring air to and from the lungs

Diaphragm - muscle that moves up and down to help your lungs to expand
