ADD -ER TO SHORT ADJECTIVES

CHANGE THE "Y" TO "I" AND ADD -ER IN ADJECTIVES ENDING IN Y

DOUBLE THE LAST CONSONANT AND ADD -ER TO SHORT ADJECTIVES ENDING IN CONSONANT+VOWEL+CONSONANT

hot →

big →

thin →


ADD "MORE" BEFORE LONG ADJECTIVES



boring →

exciting →

relaxing →



We use "than" after comparative adjectives.

E.g.: The new house is **bigger than** the old house.



some exceptions are "good" "bad" and "far":
"better", "worse" and "farther"
