



Unit 1: Reported Speech

When we use reported speech, we are telling someone what another person said.

CHANGES



PRESENT SIMPLE

"I see my flowers from here"

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

"I am growing carrots this year"

PAST SIMPLE

"I forgot my rake yesterday"

PRESENT PERFECT

"I have planted new seeds here"

WILL

"I will take care of your garden next month"

MUST / HAVE TO

"I must water these sunflowers now"

CAN

"You can call me tomorrow"

PAST SIMPLE

She said (that) she saw her flowers from there.

PAST CONTINUOUS

She said (that) she was growing carrots that year.

PAST PERFECT

She said (that) she had forgotten her rake the previous day.

PAST PERFECT

She said (that) she had planted new seeds there.

WOULD

She said (that) she would take care of my garden the following month.

HAD TO

She said (that) she had to water those sunflowers then.

COULD

She said (that) I could call her the following day.

MAY (probability)

"It may rain next week"

MAY (permission)

"You may borrow my gardening tools today"

MIGHT

She said (that) it might rain the following week.

COULD

She said (that) I could borrow her gardening tools that day.

Some notes:

OTHER CHANGES

NOW → THEN

TODAY → THAT DAY

YESTERDAY → THE PREVIOUS DAY

LAST MONTH, WEEK... → THE PREVIOUS MONTH, WEEK...

AGO → BEFORE

TOMORROW → THE NEXT/ FOLLOWING DAY

NEXT WEEK ... → THE NEXT / FOLLOWING WEEK

THIS → THAT

THESE → THOSE

HERE → THERE

COMMANDS

TO+infinitivo

"Be careful with the insects!"

She told me to be careful with the insects.

NOT TO + infinitivo

"Don't transplant daisies in winter"

She told/advised me not to transplant daisies in winter.
