

Shakti Sthal Which means 'Place of Power and strength' is the memorial site of Mrs. Indira Gandhi, the first and only female Prime Minister of India named after her strong determination and positive attitude towards the betterment of her country. The memorial is situated between Raj Ghat and Shanti Vana, commemorating the death of Indira Gandhi on 31st October 1984 and her last rites were performed over here on 3rd November 1984. The tomb on her funeral spot is made of grey-red monolithic stone.



True FACT

Former Prime Minister PV Narasimha Rao has got a memorial in his name 10 years after his demise at 'Rashtriya Smriti' close to the memorials of all former Presidents and Prime Ministers in the nation capital. Shri P.V. Narasimha Rao was born on 28th June, 1921 in Laknepalli Village, Warangal district in Telangana state. He was called the 'Brihaspati' (wiseman) of Andhra Pradesh.
