# Beautiful Crafts

1. It is a method of producing coloured designs on clothes by dyeing them. The parts not to be dyed are first coated with removable wax. Then the cloth is dyed. After drying, the wax is gently removed.
2. It is the art of creating images by arranging together small, coloured pieces of glass, tile, stone, etc. It is an ancient decorative form dating back to the 3rd millennium BCE.
3. It is a Persian craft in which a coloured glassy substance, called enamel, is coated on certain metals in decorative patterns. It is mostly used in designing jewellery.
4. It is the art of folding paper into various shapes. It was first developed by the Chinese and was later adopted by the Japanese. The use of cuts or glue is not allowed.
5. It is a metal handicraft that originated in Bihar and Karnataka in the 14th century BCE. In this, a silver sheet and a wire are inlaid into pieces of black alloy.
6. It is a technique of making a durable hand-made lace by looping and knotting a single thread. It is also used to make mats, collars and other decorative pieces.
7. It is the process of inlaying very thin layers of wood and other materials such as ivory, metal, etc. to create a picture or pattern.
8. It is the art of producing decorative handwriting. It is mostly used in event invitations, logo designs, religious art, cut-stone inscriptions, etc.
