1. This museum is also known as the National Museum of Mankind. It is located on the Shamla Hills in Bhopal. This museum was established in 1947. It is spread over 40 hectares and has authentic replicas of Indian tribal dwellings built by the tribal people themselves.

2. This museum in Cairo is home to more than 1,00,000 items of ancient Egyptian antiquities. There are many artefacts such as a collection of papyrus and coins from the last two dynasties of ancient Egypt and also many artefacts taken from the Valley of the Kings. Most popular is the tomb of Tutankhamun where his golden mask is also kept.



3. This museum is one of the world's largest and most visited art museums in the world. The museum opened to the public in 1793. Its exhibits come from all over the world including ancient Egypt, classical Greece and Rome, medieval Europe, and Napoleonic France.

4. This museum is located in the former Law Building in India. It has a collection of rare bronzes and stone sculptures from the Pallava and Chola dynasties and artifacts excavated from Arikamedu (an ancient port just 7 km from the city that had trade links with the Roman Empire). This museum also houses the earlier version of the rickshaws- Pousse-Pousse.
