



5. This museum was opened to the public on the 13th February 1982. It is located in Bhopal. It has a Tribal Art Gallery, which houses a large collection of terracotta figures, wall paintings, wood carvings and metal sculptures created by craftsmen in Bastar.

6. This museum was officially renamed Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya. It is the main museum of Mumbai. It is very famous for its great sculptures and miniature paintings.



7. This museum houses a large collection of magnificent Pahari paintings, sculptures, coins, handicrafts and photos. It was opened in 1974 with the aim to protect the cultural wealth of the state of India.

8. This famous museum is located in Hyderabad. It has more than 40,000 objects that once belonged to the royal family of Hyderabad between 1899 and 1949.



9. This museum was founded in the 6th century by Pope Julius II. The museum is known for its spiral staircase and the painting in the Sistine Chapel done by Michaelangelo.
