


6. They are one of the six biggest kinds of snakes in the world. They can grow up to 4-6 metres in length. The largest ones are always females. Their hinged jaws can separate which allows them to swallow larger prey almost four to five times larger than their head.

True FACT

A shark does not have a single bone in its entire body. Its entire skeletal system is made of cartilage. Their skin is covered with small-teeth like structures called denticles. These denticles not only help protect them from other predators but also have hydrodynamic function.
