- “Can you help me with this project?” she said. → She asked if I ____ help her with that project.
- “Don’t touch that button!” the technician warned us. → The technician warned us ____ touch that button.
- “We have to submit the report today,” they said. → They said they ____ to submit the report that day.
- “How long have they been waiting?” he asked. → He asked how long they ____ been waiting.
