**The Tango Crown!**

In 2022, the World Tango Championship was held in the city of Buenos Aires from September 6th to 18th. More than 550 couples from 30 countries took part in the event, including dancers from the United States, France, Russia, Japan, and the Philippines. It was the first full festival since the COVID-19 pandemic, so people were very excited. The previous year, foreign contestants had to participate online, using Zoom. More than 20,000 people attended the music and dance shows, according to the organisers. The festival ended with a big show in front of the historic Buenos Aires Obelisk, in the centre of the city.

At the qualifying events, female dancers wore high heels and shiny dresses, and the men combed their hair straight, similar to the old Argentine tango stars. Two Argentine couples were crowned as winners of the World Tango Championship. In the stage category, which included spectacular acrobatic movements, Constanza Vieyto and Ricardo Astrada from the city of Pergamino were chosen as champions after competing against 19 other couples.

Forty pairs competed in the traditional or “salon” category, dancing a tango that started in Buenos Aires many years ago. This time, the winners were Cynthia Palacios and Sebastián Bolívar from the city of Cipolletti, in the province of Mendoza. The judges said that their performance was so elegant and precise that it was impossible not to give them the title.

This year, the event was considered such an important cultural celebration that many tourists travelled to Buenos Aires just to watch the competition. Hotels and restaurants in the area were full, and many visitors said they were happy to experience the tango in its original home.

### Section R2 (7 marks)

#### A. La Catedral Milonga

La Catedral is a famous tango club known for its relaxed and artistic atmosphere. It offers beginner tango lessons every evening, and the classes are open to all visitors over 16. After the lessons, guests can stay to enjoy live orchestras. Drinks and snacks are also available at the bar. Tickets cost \$10, and no partner is required.

#### B. El Patio del Centro

This outdoor milonga takes place in a large square in the centre of Buenos Aires. It offers free chairs and cushions, and dancers can use mats and fans provided by the organisers. The milonga is held only outdoors, and the music is played by local DJs. Entry is free, but donations are welcome.

---

### C. Tango Sur School

Located in the neighbourhood of San Telmo, this school offers special tango courses only for adults, including technique lessons and musicality workshops. Some of the rooms have been restored from old colonial houses, giving the place a traditional feel. The school offers a 15% discount for families who book more than one course.

---

### D. Paseo de los Balarines

This is a cultural programme organised by the city. It includes free transport to different milongas, museums, and tango cafés during weekends. The buses run every hour and are easy to spot. Visitors just need to show their tourist pass to join the route.

---

### E. Costa del Río Milonga

This is a popular riverside milonga where people can dance on a wooden deck. There is direct access to walkway along the side of a river, and many tourists enjoy walking there before dancing. The place also offers equipment rentals, such as dance shoes and practice skirts. Some activities, like sunset classes, must be booked in advance.
