4. This is the largest spider in the world. Found in South America, this spider grows upto 12 inches long. This spider does not built a web but lives in the burrows. _____
5. This female spider is larger than the male. It gets its name from the popular belief that the female eat the male after mating. It is an extremely poisonous spider with fangs, big enough to penetrate the human skin. _____
6. This is the world's deadliest spider. Its venom can kill people in less than two hours. _____
7. This large spider has poison hair on its body. It can measure upto 10 cm in length. _____
8. This is the family of spiders that is known to have hunting methods that resemble a pack of wolves. _____
