2. This is one of India's famous traditional game played by children in street. It is played with two wooden sticks. One stick is three inches long and another is two feet long. \_\_\_\_\_
3. Seven flat stones are placed on top of each other to form a small tower. One side tries to break the pile, the other tries to rebuild it, before getting hit by one of the opponent. \_\_\_\_\_
4. The practitioners of this ancient martial art have to develop acrobatic abilities and use swords and knives to attack the opponent. \_\_\_\_\_
5. This horse-riding game came to be considered a war game by the Ottoman Turks. This game is still alive in Iran, Afghanistan, Turkmenistan and other Asian countries inhabited by Turkish origin. \_\_\_\_\_
6. This traditional style of fighting with sticks originated in Kurinji hills, Kerala about 5,000 years ago. This game has now spread to Malaysia as well. \_\_\_\_\_
7. One of the most popular traditional sport of India, this is a modified form of 'Run-Chase' which involves choosing and touching a person. \_\_\_\_\_
8. This Ancient Greek game was a mixture of boxing and wrestling. \_\_\_\_\_
