

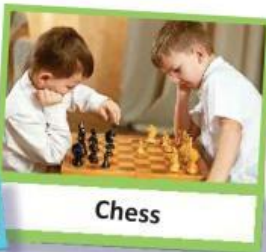
Board games are fun, friendly and make for great family entertainment. They can be played by two or more people on a pre-marked board with counter and pieces that move across it.

1. A wonderful word game that is exciting to play. The board has 15 squares to a side, a total of 225 squares. There are 100 letter tiles including blanks. _____
2. This board game is a mind game. It needs a lot of concentration. It has 64 squares with alternate squares of white and black. _____
3. It is the simplest and the oldest board game which can be played on paper. _____
4. The objective of this game is to move from your home triangle to the one opposite first. The board is shaped like a hexagram. _____
5. This is one of the oldest board game for two players. Its name suggests that the pieces have to go back to the beginning. It is played with a dice. It is a mixture of luck and skill. _____
6. The object of this game is to capture or blockade all the opponent's pieces. The checker board has 64 squares. _____
7. A popular game in which the board is divided into four squares and can be played by two to four players. It is played with a dice and blue, red, green and yellow discs. _____
8. This game originated in India. Four players sit around a cross-shaped board. They throw cowrie shells to see how many spaces they can move. _____
9. This board game is won by luck. No skill or trick is required. It has hundred squares on it. _____
10. It is a Chinese board game. It is played with a combination of dice and dominoes, with 144 rectangular tiles engraved with Chinese symbols. _____
