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7. Instituted in 1954, this award recognises and promotes excellence in writing. It is the second highest literary honour in India.

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8. It is India's highest award in cinema. It is presented annually at the National Film Awards ceremony by the Directorate of Film Festivals.

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9. It is the Lifetime Achievement Award in sports and games. It is named after a legendary hockey player.

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10. These awards are for exceptional and distinguished service in any field including services rendered by government servants.

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
