## How to form comparative adjectives?

### 1. Add “-er” to short adjectives (1 syllable)

Examples:

- **small** → **smaller**
- **tall** → **taller**
- **fast** → **faster**

### 2. If the adjective ends with “e”, just add “-r”

Examples:

- **nice** → **nicer**
- **large** → **larger**

### 3. If the adjective ends with a consonant + vowel + consonant, double the last letter and add “-er”

Examples:

- **big** → **bigger**
- **hot** → **hotter**
- **sad** → **sadder**

### 4. For longer adjectives (2 or more syllables), use “more + adjective”

Examples:


- **beautiful** → **more beautiful**
- **exciting** → **more exciting**
- **careful** → **more careful**

### 5. Always use the word “than” after the comparative

Examples:

- **Ali is taller than Amir.**
- **This book is more interesting than that one.**


