<p>Uncle Tom often <b>drives</b> his car.  <b>is driving</b>  <b>drive</b></p> 	<p>What time <b>do they getting up</b>?  <b>does</b> <b>gets up</b>  <b>are</b> <b>get up</b></p> 
<p>Where is Mum?          She <b>am cooking</b> in the kitchen.  <b>is cooking</b>  <b>cooks</b></p> 	<p>I <b>doesn't take</b> the dog for a walk every day.  <b>don't take</b>  <b>am not taking</b></p> 
<p>Emma sometimes <b>help</b> her Mum with the housework.  <b>is helping</b>  <b>helps</b></p> 	<p>Where <b>are they living</b>? In a house or a flat?  <b>does</b> <b>lives</b>  <b>do</b> <b>live</b></p> 
<p>I <b>brush</b> my teeth now.  <b>am brushing</b>  <b>is brushing</b></p> 	<p>Bill <b>doesn't running</b> now.  <b>isn't</b> <b>run</b></p>
