Recount Text



You often tell stories about your past – your holiday, your birthday, or a special event. That kind of story is called a Recount Text.

What is a Recount Text?

Aspect	Explanation
Purpose	To tell about past events or experiences.
Generic Structure	1) Orientation (who, where, when) 2) Events (what happened in order) 3) Reorientation (closing or comment)
Language Features	1) Simple Past Tense (went, saw, was) 2) Action Verbs (played, visited, enjoyed) 3) Time Connectives (then, after that, finally)
