Where		you	go?	I	went to the beach.
Who	did	he	go with?	He	went with my family.
What		she	see?	She	saw a train.

I	I	go skiing.
He		go sledging.
She		make a snowman.
We	won't	make soup.
		make a bird feeder.
		do crafts.

Look!

We often use *will* after *I think* and *I don't think*.

I think I'll go skiing.

I don't think we'll win.

Remember! We don't say:

I think we won't win.

We use **will** / **won't** + infinitive to talk about future actions.

We use **will** / **won't** + infinitive to talk about something happening now.
