

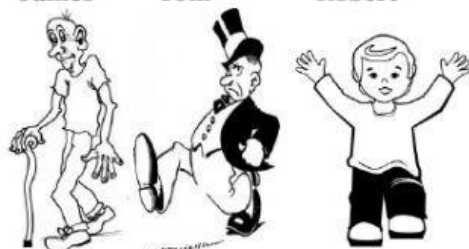
Comparatives and Superlatives

- 3) Robert is the (fat)



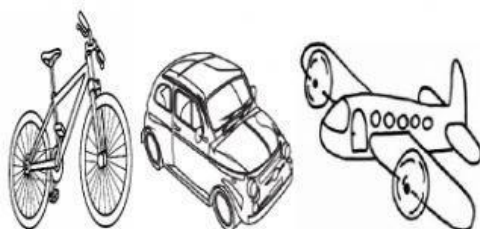
Oliver David John

- 1) The leopard isthan the rabbit. (fast)

Bicycle Car Plane

- 1) The bicycle isthan the car. (comfortable)
- 2) The plane isthan the car. (comfortable)
- 3) The plane is the(comfortable)



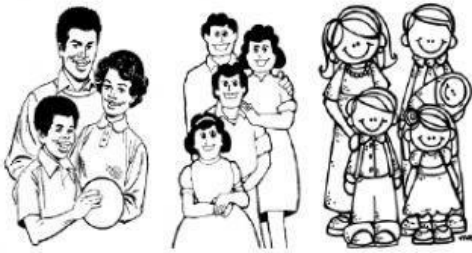
Sam Tom Max

- 3) Sam is the (angry)



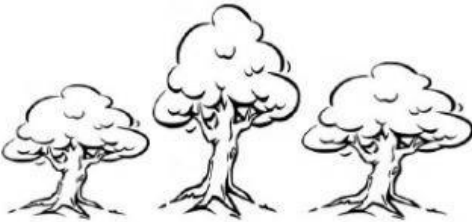
Football Tennis Basketball

- 1) Ann's family isthan David's family. (large)
- 2) David's family isthan George's family. (Small)
- 3) George's family is the (large)



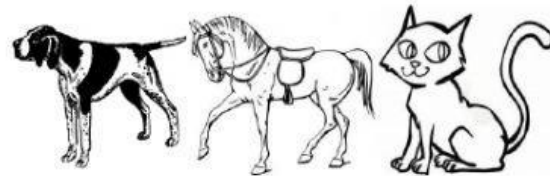
Tree 1 Tree 2 Tree 3

- 1) Tree 1 isthan tree 2. (short)
- 2) Tree 2 isthan tree 3. (tall)
- 3) Tree 1 is the (short)



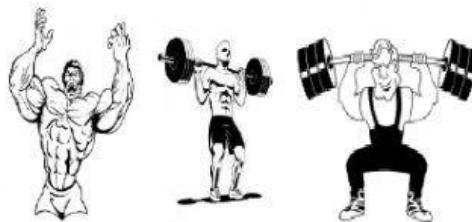
Sarah Jane Maria

- 1) Sarah isthan Jane. (sad)
- 2) Maria isthan Sarah. (sad)
- 3) Maria is the (sad)



Dog Horse Cat

- 1) The dog isthan the cat. (friendly)
- 2) The horse isthan the cat. (friendly)
- 3) The dog is the (friendly)



Bill Kevin Matthew

- 1) Kevin isthan Robert. (strong)
- 2) Matthew isthan Kevin. (weak)
- 3) Bill is the (strong)



Jonathan Einstein Brian

- 1) Brian isthan Jonathan. (intelligent)
- 2) Jonathan isthan Einstein. (intelligent)
- 3) Einstein is the (intelligent)
